Disorderly Conduct Arrest on Elm Street

Officer Michael Roscoe was patrolling Elm Street at 1:25 a.m. this morning when his attention was drawn to a male subject screaming at two women in front of 1087 Elm Street. The officer heard the man swearing at the two women so he asked him to stand by while he spoke with the females, but the man refused and took an aggressive stance.

The man refused to provide identification for the officer. Another officer arrived on scene and positively identified him as Denali Pierce, 27 of Manchester, New Hampshire. Pierce not only refused to provide identification but continued his profanity laced tirade as the officers attempted to calm him down. Several people leaving area establishments walked by as Pierce continued his disorderly behavior, so he was taken into custody.

The officers handcuffed him, but Pierce remained non-compliant as the officers attempted to complete a search incident to arrest. He was charged with disorderly conduct and resisting arrest/detention. He remained uncooperative throughout the process. He is currently at Valley Street Jail awaiting an arraignment in the 9th Circuit Court-Manchester later this morning.
